Southborough Library Eaton Room Exhibitor Policy

- The Southborough Library allows artists on a first-come, first-serve basis to exhibit/display art in the Eaton Meeting Room in the Library's lower floor so long as said exhibit does not conflict with library services and programs. Exhibits generally last two months, but this varies at the discretion of the Library Director.
- Southborough and its Library are not responsible for the care and safety of works displayed.
- The artist understands that insurance to protect his/her work is not available through the Town or the Library while it is in the care, custody, and control of the Library. Any insurance carried on this work shall be paid for and carried by the artist as s/he chooses.
- The Southborough Library does not endorse the viewpoints or artistic expression of exhibitors, and will not disallow exhibits solely based upon controversial content or because of the beliefs or affiliations of those whose work is represented.
- Artists will put up and take down their own shows. No storage space is available to exhibitors.
- The Library takes no commission. Price lists are made available to patrons upon request.
- The Library is not responsible for advertising the exhibit, but may choose to do so. The artist understands that, owing to the nature of the exhibit space as a public meeting, exhibits may be temporarily unavailable for viewing due to programs, meetings, and other events being held in the room. Those programs, meetings, and events may not be interrupted to accommodate viewers of the exhibit.
