

Southborough Library Seed Exchange: Next Steps

As flower heads begin to fade, it is time to collect seeds for next spring and we need your help to grow the Southborough Library Seed Exchange!

Follow these steps during the summer months:

1. Cut flower head with scissors or a knife.
2. Collect the ripe seeds from the flower head and place on waxed paper.
3. Allow the seeds to dry for about a week.
4. Clean the seeds by removing any husks or pods.
5. Place seeds in an envelope and seal.
6. Sow the seeds in spring and share the rest with the exchange library.

We are happy to store the seeds for use in our Seed Exchange for next year.
